ORDER:

The Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Madras has requested the Government for recognition of the Diploma in Handloom Technology, awarded by the All India Handloom Board through the Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Salem on par with the Diploma course in Textile Technology awarded by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Tamil Nadu and to prescribe the above diploma as an alternative qualification for purposes of recruitment to the teaching and other categories of posts relating to Textile Designing/Weaving in Tamil Nadu State for which Diploma in Textile Technology awarded by the State Board of Technical Education has been prescribed as the qualification.

2. The Director of Technical Education in his letter 2nd read above has opined that the Diploma in Handloom Technology in question can be recognised as an alternative qualification for purposes of recruitment to the teaching and other category posts in the field of Textile Processing in this state in Tamil Nadu State, for which diploma in Textile Technology awarded by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Tamilnadu is prescribed as the qualification. The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission is of the view that the diploma in Handloom technology awarded by the All India Handloom Board through the Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Salem be considered as equivalent to the Diploma in Textile Technology awarded by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Tamil Nadu.

3. The Government accordingly direct that the Diploma Course in Handloom Technology, awarded by the All India Handloom Board through the Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Salem, be recognised and equivalent to the Diploma in Textile Technology, awarded by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Tamil Nadu. They also direct that the above Diploma be

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aken as alternative qualification for purposes of recruitment to the Teaching and other category posts relating to Textile Designing/Weaving in Tamil Nadu State, for which diploma in Textile Technology awarded by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Tamil Nadu is prescribed as the qualification. The Director of Technical Education is requested to send drafts amendments to the special rules and adhoc rules wherever necessary.

In the G.O. cited, Government have ordered that the
 Diploma Course in Handloom Technology awarded by the
 All India Board, through the Indian Institute of Handloom
 Technology, Salem be recognised as equivalent to the
 Diploma in Textile Technology awarded by the State Board
 of Technical Education and Training, Tamil Nadu.
 In the letter second cited the Government of India have
 intimated that the Diploma is being awarded directly by
 the Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, functioning
 at Salem (i.e. not through the All India Handloom Board)
 under the direct administrative control of the office of
 Development Commissioner for Handloom, Ministry of Textiles,
 Government of India. In pursuance of this, it is
 clarified that the above Diploma issue by the Indian
 Institute of Handloom Technology, Salem shall be treated
 as equivalent to Diploma in Textile Technology awarded
 by the State Board of Technical Education.

The order issued in the G.O. shall be deemed to
 have been modified accordingly.
