ORDER:

In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Technical Education has stated that the total Life time allocation to establish each of the Centres of Excellence selected in TEQIP-II under the Sub-Component 1.2.1 is Rs. 5,00,00,000/-. A sum of Rs.3,33,33,000/- was already released to establish Centre of Excellence – Alternate Energy Research (COE-AER) in Government College of Technology, Coimbatore in the Government order first read above. The balance amount of Rs.1,66,67,000/- has to be released. The Director of Technical Education has further stated that the MHRD, Government of India is providing financial assistance of Rs.83, 33, 500/- (Rupees Eighty Three Lakh Thirty Three thousand and Five hundred only) as 50% of its grants as balance fund to "Centre of Excellence in Alternate Energy Research" in Government College of Technology, Coimbatore. The Government of India while according administrative sanction to establish the " Centre of Excellence in Alternate Energy Research" has released a sum of Rs.64,58,500/- (Rupees Sixty Four Lakh Fifty Eight Thousand and Five Hundred only) under General Scheme, Rs.12,50,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakh and Fifty Thousand only) under SC Scheme and Rs.6,25,000/- (Rupees Six Lakh and Twenty Five Thousand only) under ST Scheme as the balance fund out of Rs. 5,00,00,000/- in the Financial Year 2105-16 to the above Centre of Excellence. i.e. 50% of the grant to two States such as Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh as Central share. Remaining 50% shares has to be released by the State. Earlier as per the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed between the Government of India and the State Government, the MHRD- Higher Education Department, for the TEQIP-II Project a Centrally Sponsored Scheme has stated that, the Central share of the Financial Assistance by GOI is 75% and the State share is 25%. But in this release of the fund in this Financial Year 2015-16, the sharing pattern of the Financial Assistance to the State is revised as 50% Central share and the remaining 50% has to be shared by the State Government.

2. The Director of Technical Education has also stated that the Government of India while according administrative sanction to implement the Project TEQIP-II, has

released the balance fund of Rs. 83,33,500/- as Central share to the Centre of Excellence in Alternate Energy Research as detailed below:-

The Director of Technical Education has further stated that since the Central and the State sharing pattern is now revised as 50% each, the State share to the Centre of Excellence in Alternate Energy Research is also same as that in the above table. The total fund to be released under the three Schemes to the above Centre of Excellence - COE-AER is as follows:-

The Director of Technical Education has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of **Rs. 1,66,67,000/-** to Government College of Technology, Coimbatore for establishing Centre of Excellence in Alternate Energy Research by including its 50% share amount (**Rs.83,33,500/-**) as detailed below for implementing TEQIP-II:-

The Government after careful examination, sanction and release a sum of Rs. 1,66,67,000/- (Rupees one crore sixty six lakh and sixty seven thousand only) (Rs. 83.335 lakh Central Government's share (50%) + Rs. 83.335 lakh State Government's share (50%)) to the Director of Technical Education towards the balance fund for establishing Centre of Excellence in Alternate Energy Research in Government College of Technology, Coimbatore in the financial year 2015 -16 under TEQIP-II in Sub-Component 1.2.1 as detailed in para 2 above.
