expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2016-17 to Finance (BG-I) Department without fail.

The Director of Technical Education shall take all necessary steps for the implementation of the Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme Phase –II as per the schedule of National Project Implementation Unit. She is also requested to send the action taken report to Government in due course.
