Technical Education – Nomination of Chairman and State Government nominee, members to the Board of Governors of the three Government Engineering Colleges selected under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP) – Phase II viz. Government College of Technology, Coimbatore, Alagappa Chettiar College of Engineering and Technology, Karaikudi, Government College of Engineering, Salem and two Government Engineering Colleges selected under TEQIP – Phase I viz. Government College of Engineering, Tirunelveli and Thanthai Periyar Government Institute of Technology, Vellore – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Board of Governors were constituted in the 11 Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme institutions. In the Government Order second read above, the Government have appointed Chairman to the Board of Governors of the institutions implementing Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme. In the Government Order third read above, orders were issued appointing Ex-Officio Financial Advisor and Chief Accounts Officer (F.A. & C.A.O.), Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai as State Government nominee from Finance Department and Ex-officio Additional Director (Exam), Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai as State Government nominee (Educationalist) as Members of BOG for the TEQIP institutions.

2. The Commissioner of Technical Education in his letter 31.12.2012 fourth read above has stated that the tenure of Chairman and other members of Board of Governors have ended on 6.11.2012 for the following 5 Government Engineering Colleges :-

- (1) Government College of Technology, Coimbatore.
- (2) Alagappa Chettiar College of Engineering and Technology, Karaikudi.
- (3) Government College of Engineering, Salem.
- (4) Government College of Engineering, Tirunelveli.
- (5) Thanthai Periyar Government Institute of Technology, Vellore.

He has therefore requested the Government to nominate Chairman and other Members of Board of Governors for the above 5 institutions. He has also requested the permission of Government to retain the Ex-Officio Additional Director (Exams), Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai as State Government nominee (Educationalist) and Ex-Officio Financial Advisor and Chief Accounts Officer (F.A.&CAO), Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai as State Government nominee in the Board of Governors of the above five institutions. Among the above five Engineering Colleges, the following two Engineering Colleges have not been selected under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme-II:-

- (1) Government College of Engineering, Tirunelveli.
- (2) Thanthai Periyar Government Institute of Technology, Vellore.

Eventhen, in the letter dated 21.1.2015, the Commissioner of Technical Education has stated that constitution of Board of Governors (BoG) in the Institutions is one of the reforms of Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme Phase-I to monitor the academic and non-academic reforms and also to improve the management system of the Institutions. Without achieving the targets and excellence by the Institution, if the reforms like Board of Governors implemented in Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme Phase-I is withdrawn, the improvements brought in through the Programme would be lost and the amount spent by the State Government will be wasted and lost. Further the constitution of Board of Governors is one of the eligibility conditions to be satisfied by Engineering Colleges for selection under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme Phase-III, which is expected to be implemented in the year 2016. The Board of Governors to these two institutions need to be continued as per UGC guidelines & G.O. first read above and to sustain the excellence achieved in these Institutions. Therefore, he has requested the Government to nominate Chairman and other Members of Board of Governors for the above 2 institutions.

3. The Government after careful examination, issue orders appointing the following persons to the Board of Governors of the three Government Engineering Colleges selected under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP) – Phase II viz. Government College of Technology, Coimbatore, Alagappa Chettiar College of Engineering and Technology, Karaikudi, Government College of Engineering, Salem and two Government Engineering Colleges selected under TEQIP – Phase I viz. Government College of Engineering, Tirunelveli and Thanthai Periyar Government Institute of Technology, Vellore for a period of two years from the date of issue of this order, under the categories as detailed below:-
