



Technical Education – Nomination of Chairman and State Government nominee, members to the Board of Governors of the three Government Polytechnic Colleges selected under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP) – Phase I viz. Central Polytechnic College, Chennai, Dr.Dharmambal Government Polytechnic Colleges for Women, Chennai and Tamil Nadu Polytechnic College, Madurai – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government order second read above, the Government have appointed Chairman to the Board of Governors for the following eight TEQIP Institutions:-

- (1) Government College of Technology, Coimbatore.
- (2) Alagappa Chettiar College of Engineering and Technology, Karaikudi.
- (3) Government College of Engineering, Salem.
- (4) Government College of Engineering, Tirunelveli.
- (5) Thanthai Periyar Government Institute of Technology, Vellore.
- (6) Central Polytechnic College, Chennai.
- (7) Dr.Dharmambal Government Polytechnic Colleges for Women, Chennai.
- (8) Tamil Nadu Polytechnic College, Madurai.

2. In the Government Order third read above, Ex-Officio Financial Advisor and Chief Accounts Officer (F.A. & C.A.O.), Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai has been nominated as State Government nominee from Finance Department and Ex-officio Additional Director (Examination), Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai as State Government nominee (Educationalist) to the Board of Governors to the TEQIP Institutions.

3. In the Government Order fifth read above, the Government have appointed Chairman and Members to the Board of Governors of the following five Government Engineering Colleges:-

- (1) Government College of Technology, Coimbatore.
- (2) Alagappa Chettiar College of Engineering and Technology, Karaikudi.

- (3) Government College of Engineering, Salem.
- (4) Government College of Engineering, Tirunelveli.
- (5) Thanthai Periyar Government Institute of Technology, Vellore.

4. The Commissioner of Technical Education in his letters third read above has stated that as per University Grants Commission guidelines, the term of the Board Of Governors members is only for two years except the University Grants Commission nominee. In this regard, the tenure of Chairman and other members of BOG have been completed on 16.11.2012 for the following institutions:-

1. Central Polytechnic College, Chennai
2. Dr.Dharmambal Government Polytechnic College
for Women, Chennai
3. Tamil Nadu Polytechnic College, Madurai

Therefore, he has requested the orders from the Government to nominate the Chairman, members and nominees to the Board of Governors of the above said three Polytechnic colleges. The Commissioner of Technical Education in his letter dated 12.5.2015 has stated that it is necessary to reconstitute the Board of Governors (BOG) for the three Government Polytechnic Colleges namely Central Polytechnic College, Chennai, Dr.Dharmambal Government Polytechnic College for Women, Chennai and Tamilnadu Polytechnic College, Madurai in which the Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme Phase-I (TEQIP-I) is implemented and also to sustain the benefits and improve the quality of technical education due to implementation of the Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme-I in these colleges. He has further stated that for the sustainability of the above implemented reforms beyond TEQIP Phase-I, it is very much necessary to reconstitute Board of Governors (BoG) in these Institutions to supervise, guide and regulate proper utilization of budget /Block Grant fund, proper exercise of the above functions and shall held accountable to auditors for proper expenditure to Government and legislature towards correct usage of budgetary resources to meet the objectives outlined in the policy note submitted to the legislature. To maintain the Academic, Managerial, Administrative and Financial Autonomy in the Institutions and to show development in the Institutions reconstitution of Board of Governors is important. Tamil Nadu State with the aim to produce high quality Technical Professional through reforms in the Technical / Engineering Education system, signed the Project Agreement of TEQIP with International Development Association (IDA) (World Bank) and agreed to implement the reforms in the Colleges to achieve the goals for excellence and sustain the same with autonomy and accountability.

5. The Commissioner of Technical Education has therefore requested orders to nominate the Chairman and members to the Board of Governors for the above three Government Polytechnic colleges selected under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme Phase-I Institutions as per the Government order first read above. He has requested for permission for Ex-officio Assistant Director (Planning), Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai as Nominee of the University/ Board and Ex-officio Financial Advisor & Chief Accounts Officer (F.A & C.A.O), Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai-25 to continue as State Government Nominee from Finance Department.

6. The Government after careful examination, issue orders appointing the following persons to the Board of Governors of the three Government Polytechnic Colleges selected under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP) -- Phase I, viz. Central Polytechnic College, Chennai, Dr.Dharmambal Government

Polytechnic College for Women, Chennai and Tamil Nadu Polytechnic College, Madurai for a period of two years from the date of issue of this order, under the categories as detailed below:-
