Sub: Technical Education – AICTE Approval Process for the Academic Year 2022-23 – Merging of Second Shift & Part Time Approved Intake with the Regular Approved Intake – Furnishing Clarification – Regarding.

Ref: AICTE Approval Process Hand Book 2022-23.

The Clause 7.10 of AICTE Approval Process Hand Book 2022-23 is as follows:

"The Courses offered in the timings of Regular Shift, Second Shift and Part Time shall be considered as Regular Courses. The Institutions shall have to fulfill all facilities such as Infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements to offer the Regular Courses as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 21-22 for the Total Approved Intake and the Institutions may conduct the Courses in the timings of Regular Shift, First Shift, Second Shift and Part Time not exceeding the "Approved Intake" of each Course, as per the convenience of all stakeholders. All such Institutions shall have to create the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities WITHIN 1 YEAR (by A/Y 2022-23) to fulfil the norms and an affidavit for the same shall have to be submitted to AICTE. Student enrolment details shall be uploaded in the Web-Portal."

As per the above said clause, the repetition of nomenclature of courses in the AICTE EOA for 2022-23 is not possible. The approved intake of Second Shift & Part Time courses are to be merged with the approved intake of Regular Course and the approved intake of Aided Courses and SF Courses are also to be merged.

Hence, the instructions of AICTE should be followed by the institutions. However, to distinct the Aided and Self Supporting courses admission and other related issues, as an affiliating body it is instructed to follow the existing procedures.
